## Abstract

The manuscript you submit will be used as it is in the Technical Digest. To ensure that the paper will be reproduced clearly and in proper size, authors should observe following instructions. The manuscript must be typed in two columns to a page on white A4 size papers. The number of pages is limited to 2 for all papers. Please give an abstract not more than 150 words at the top of the manuscript. The abstract should clearly state the outline of paper. This document is itself an example of page layout. The deadline of manuscript submission is May 18, 2007.

*Keywords: Optical MEMS, Nanophotonics, optics, microsystem, conference*  
*The number of keywords should be **five or less**. Keywords are to be separated by comma.*

## 1 INTRODUCTION

Authors wishing to present a paper at Optical MEMS and Nanophotonics 2007 are to submit 2-page extended abstract in the format given here by May 18, 2007. Accepted papers will be used as the final manuscript to be included in the conference technical digest to be distributed at the conference in Hualien, Taiwan.

## 2 STYLE AND FORMAT

Manuscript must be typed in two columns to a page on white A4 size papers. Use one side only. Please fit the manuscript inside the margins of approximately 180 mm by 240 mm (width x height). This is approximately 7 inches by 10 inches. Information on external margins is indicated in the Table 1 below. Any texts or figures outside this area will be lost. We recommend 10-point, proportional-spaced type font such as Times or Times New Roman. This sample uses the 10-point Times New Roman font. Do not use language restrictive fonts such as Chinese, Russian, Japanese, or Korean fonts in the text or the figures, because they are not reproduced properly and pdf files containing such fonts sometimes cannot be opened. Use standard Western and Symbol fonts only.

Manuscript must be typed single-spaced. One line space should be inserted between paragraphs. No indentation is necessary at the beginning of the paragraph.

### 2.1 Title

Center the title on the page so as it runs across the both columns. The title of the paper is typed in upper and lower case letters. Use 16-point font in bold. The name of the author and his precise business mailing address should follow on separate lines in upper and lower case letters.

### 2.2 Major Headings

Major headings are in capital letters and centered. If you can choose multiple styles, please use bold letters, or if not, please underline it.

### 2.3 Subheadings

Subheadings are in bold letters (or underlined) and placed flush on the left-hand margin of the column.

**A) Sub-subheading** Sub-subheadings are in bold italic letters (or underlined) and run at the beginning of the paragraph.

### 3 BIBLIOGRAPHICAL REFERENCES

List and number all bibliographical references at the end of the paper. When referring to them in the text, type the corresponding reference number in square brackets: [1]. Follow the format as shown at the end of this paper.

### 4 EQUATION NUMBERS

When numbering equations, enclose numbers in parentheses and place flush with the right-hand margin of the column.

$$N(t) = mn(t) \quad (1)$$

### 5 SYMBOLS AND ACRONYMS

Use only standard symbols and unit abbreviation. The use of the International System of Units (SI units) is advocated. Define any acronyms the first time they appear.

### 6 ILLUSTRATIONS

#### 6.1 Drawings and Photographs

Figures should be placed as close to their mention as possible. All figures and illustrations should be in black and white. Authors should avoid color images or photographs, as they will not be reproduced well in prints. On graphs, show only the coordinate axes, or at most the major grid lines, to preclude a dense hard-to-read effect.

All lettering should be large enough to remain legible after photographic reproduction, i.e., at least 2.5 mm in height.

#### 6.2 Digital Images

Digital images such as line art and photographs can be used if the output resolution is at least 600 dpi.

#### 6.3 Figure Captions

Figure captions must be typed in place preferably right below the Figure being described. Figures must be large and clear enough after photographic reproduction.

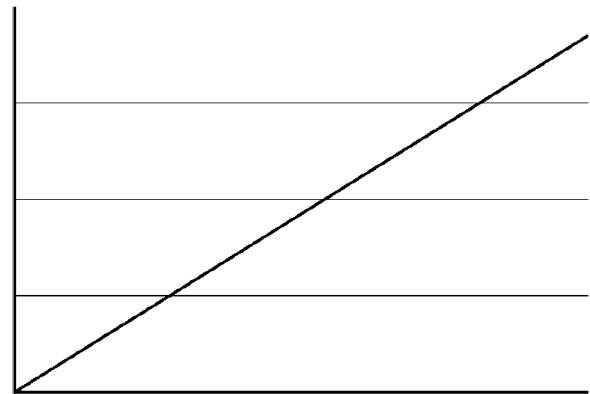


Figure 1. Figure caption right below the figure

#### 6.4 Tables

A larger table should be placed across two columns at the top or bottom of the page. Center table captions above the tables like Table 2.
